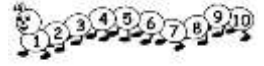

Reading records



FS2: Please continue to spend time at home going through your child's laminated phoneme cards and later words, this time is invaluable in helping your child learn to read alongside our daily focus in school 😊 Look out for numeral cards too!
